

# Pro Steam

### Professional quality recordings by Ken Mellor.

BR Standard Class 5 no. 73152, struggles to restart a late night train from the curving platform 1 at Perth with a train for Dundee. Passengers are heard in the background arguing. 28<sup>th</sup> July 1964.

On-board the final V2 railtour, hauled by 60836, between Edinburgh and Aberdeen, returning via Perth and Dundee.  $5^{th}$  November 1966:

- 2 Departing Edinburgh Waverley.
- 3 Climbing from Inverkeithing.
- 4 Climbing from Touch South Junction to Cowdenbeath, with some slight wheel-slip.
- 5 Departing Perth.
- 6 A permanent-way slack at Coupar Angus.
- 7 At speed between Stonehaven and Aberdeen.
- 8 Departing Aberdeen.
- 9 Some wheel-slip as we depart Dundee towards Tay Bridge.

- 10 Southern Class O2 4-4-2T no.18 "Ningwood" hauls out of steam locos towards the coaling stage, as a Spitfire circles overhead as part of a summer air-show. A train from Ventnor to Ryde passes. 8<sup>th</sup> August 1965.
- 11 GNR 8 foot single wheeler Number 1 makes a steady start from Loughborough Central, while on loan from the National Railway Museum. 6<sup>th</sup> December 1981.
- 12 No. 64620 (ex NBR) 0-6-0 Class J37, struggles for grip with a railtour heading up the branch to Inverbervie. 9<sup>th</sup> April 1966.
- 13 On-train behind 60532 "Blue Peter" departing Montrose for Dundee, with an SLS Easter railtour "Scottish Rambler no.5". 9<sup>th</sup> April 1966.
- 14 On-board a midday service from Ruabon to Barmouth, behind BR Standard Class 4 no.75026, making a rapid start from Berwyn. 28<sup>th</sup> January 1963.
- 15 LMS Pacific 46256 "Sir William Stanier" starts out from Carlisle with the return leg of the RCTS Scottish Lowlander railtour to Preston (on-train). 26<sup>th</sup> September 1964.
- 16 On the Lickey Incline: LMS 8F 2-8-0 ambles down with a short goods train, followed by GWR 0-6-0 tank using the same signal path. In the background can be heard LMS Class 5 4-6-0 no.44919 starting from Bromsgrove with a passenger service, which passes by banked by GWR 0-6-0 no.8402. 8<sup>th</sup> February 1964.

#### ...and finally:

17 70013 "Oliver Cromwell" climbs passed Horton in Ribblesdale on the 1 in 100 grade to Blea Moor, working the northbound "15 Guinea Special". On-train recording. 11<sup>th</sup> August 1968.
